The University of Brescia recently approved a strategic plan for the years 2014-2016, called "Health&Wealth", with which we intend to offer to the students the possibility to learn skills and innovative expertise dedicated to health and to the well-being of people and of the environment. The vision and the mission of this strategic plan have been recognized by the Ministry of Health through the signature of a specific agreement, making Brescia a privileged hub for testing new models of care and management of the health and welfare of its citizens.

The first major news concerned with our new strategy is the lauch of two advanced training courses, a master's degree course in "Science and Technology for population Health and Wealth" and a PhD in "Technology for Health", both in English.

To encourage international participation, there are calls for five scholarships for the master's degree and 2 scholarships for doctoral research, specifically dedicated to foreign students. I would like to select *the best* students, and I would like to have some of your best students in my University. So please consider than we will give special attention to those smart and motivated students you may wish to encourage to apply to either of these training programs.
