1) Singapore International Graduate Award (SINGA)

Outstanding international students given a chance to:

- Conduct **cutting-edge research** in Conduct cutting-edge research in **A*STAR** (Agency for Science, Technology and Research), **NTU** (Nanyang Technology university), **NUS** (National University of Singapore) or **SUTD** (Singapore University of Technology and Design)
- Receive a **top-tier PhD degree** from either NTU, NUS or SUTD

Award terms

- €1,600 stipend per month
- Full support for tuition fees for 4 years of PhD studies.
- One-time SGD 1,000 Settling-in Allowance (€700)
- One-time Airfare Grant of SGD 1,500 (€1,000)

Student eligibility

- Graduates with excellent academic performance
- Strong passion for research
- 2 Recommendation reports
- Good skills in written and spoken English

2) A*Star research Attachment Programme (ARAP)

- A collaboration between A*STAR and overseas universities to provide research opportunities at A*STAR Research Institutes
- PhD students from all overseas universities spend 1-2 years under joint supervision of the A*STAR researcher and the university supervisor
- PhD degree will be conferred by the university

Award Terms

- €1,600 monthly stipend for the period based at A*STAR
- Settling-in Allowance (€700)
- Airfare Grant of SGD 1,500 (€1,000)

Student Eligibility

- Enrolled in a PhD Programme with a University
- Bachelor's Degree is at least Second Class (upper) Honours or Equivalent

3) Singapore International Pre-Graduate Award (SIPGA)

- Supports 2-6 months short-terms research attachments at A*STAR Research Institutes

Award Terms

- €1,600 monthly stipend for the period based at A*STAR

Student Eligibility

- In the 3rd/4th year of undergraduate studies or doing his/her Master studies
- Bachelor's degree is on track to at least Second Class (Upper) Honors or equivalent
